1. Welcome and Apologies:

Craig advised this Special Meeting had been convened to consider whether the CCC should write to FC to apply for an extension to the consultation period in respect of an application submitted on 8th December 2011 for the **Conversion of garage to form two-storey dwelling house –The House At West Green, West Green, Culross, Fife KY12 8JH**

2. Declarations of Interest:

Craig referred to ‘The Scheme’ and advised any member of the CCC who has a declared financial interest, or a non-financial interest which he/she considers would cause a member of the public to form the view that he or she might be influenced by that interest shall withdraw from the meeting during such consideration and shall not speak or vote on any question relating to that matter. 3. Proposal to apply for extension to consultation period

This proposal was debated and it was unanimously agreed to apply for an extension until 7th February 2012, after the next meeting of the CCC scheduled to take place on 6th February 2012. This would enable Cllr’s to determine whether the development will affect the amenity of the area and informally consult the wider community to assess the extent to which they will be affected.
