AOCB:

- 3) Diane wanted it to be put on record that she felt her integrity was questioned by the applicant who had taken a photograph of the comment box. The applicant had also noted she had not been given the opportunity to sign the tape covering the comment box.
- 4) Shirley immediately made it very clear that Diane had misunderstood her intentions in taking the photograph, and it was absolutely not Shirley's intention to cast doubt on Diane's integrity.
