COALFIELD REGENERATION TRUST:

Torryburn and Newmills not shown as deprived area, but if we make 10 year plan and they reject it, we can show we are same as other villages getting money. School is a deprived area school. John Duffy spoke to them, says the villages ARE in it and asked if we can be part of next year's Budget. They don't know if they have money yet.
